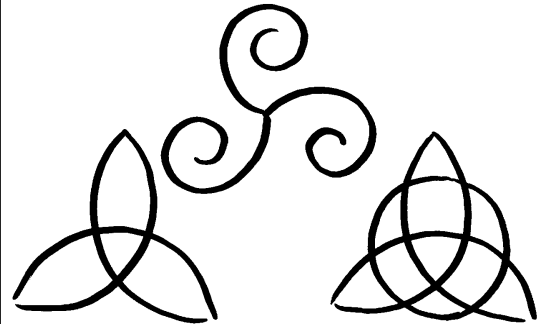
Isaiah 6:1-8 (page 675 in the Old Testament)
