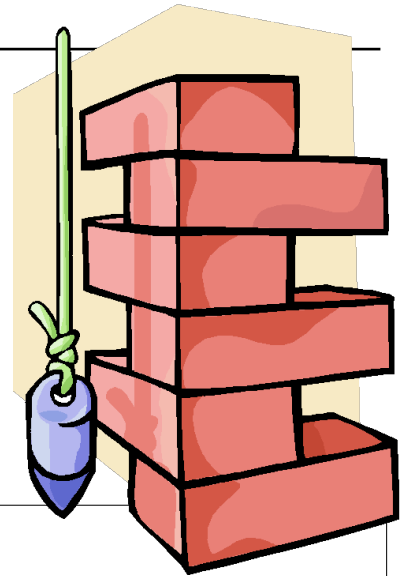
The Bible readings for this morning are:
